

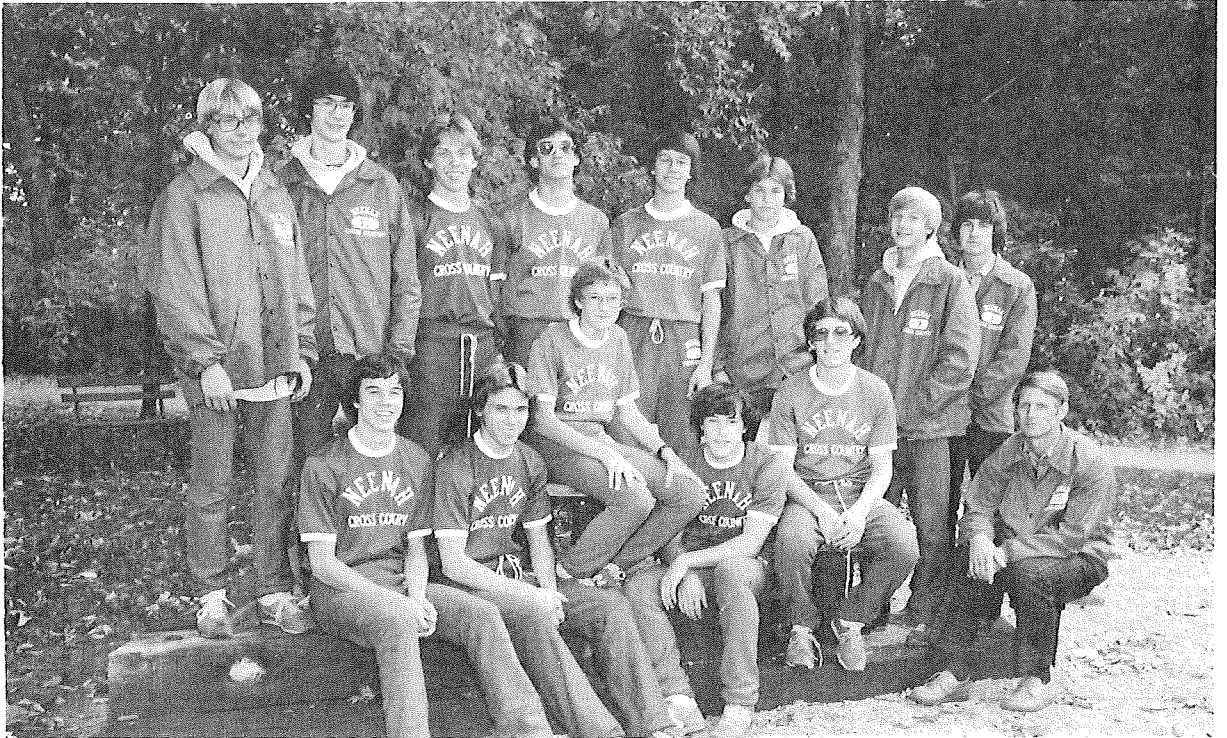

Leadership And Enthusiasm Are Combined To Post Successful Cross Country Record

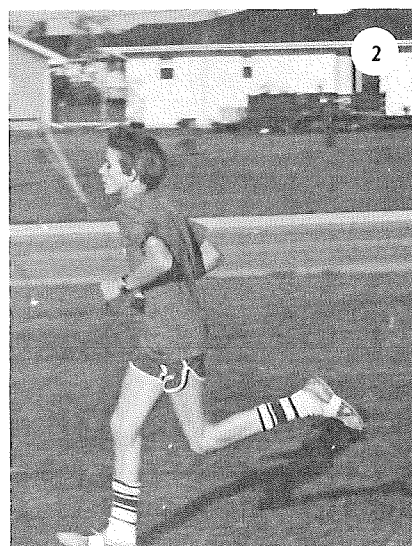
