More invitationals for N-M runners

NEENAH-MENASHA — Twin City cross country teams head in different directions for invitationals Saturday, Neenah competing at Wauwatosa East and Menasha at Wausau.

In action last weekend, the Neenah girls were first and the boys ninth at Shawano and the Menasha boys took third and the girls fifth in the Manitowoc Roncalli meet.

Coach Ron Fedenko's Neenah girls, who extended their newest winning string to 10 meets in a row, expect strong competition at Wauwatosa because Homestead and Oak Creek, two of the better teams in the Milwaukee area, are entered.

They are the defending champions in the Wauwatosa meet.

Fedenko hopes to regain the services of No. 1 runner Eileen Schaller, who didn't run at Shawano because of a sore foot.

Kathy Monard, who trailed Schaller by one second in the first two meets, won the race in 11:08. She bes-

ted Oshkosh North's Meghan McCarthy by 14 seconds.

Other Neenah places were Amy Garlock fifth, Jenny Owens sixth, Cathy Gilmore 12th, Lyn Moede 33rd, Becky Otto 46th, Jan Schaper 57th, Linda Heinen 66th and Karen Rieden 90th.

In winning with 57 points, one of their highest totals in recent years, the Rockets outscored runnerup Preble by 23 points.

The Neenah boys tallied 260 points in the meet won by Preble with 32.

Neenah places were Scott Meulemans 37th, Jeff Wheeler 52nd, Alex Collins 55th, Alex Scribner 57th, Russ Stern 59th, Jeff Enz 60th, Glen Smith 62nd and Peter Dunlavy 65th.

The Bluejay boys totaled 83 points to 39 for Premontre and 62 for Schofield D.C. Everest.

Menasha's Tom Severson was defeated for the first time in three starts when he finished fourth.

Jeff Vollmer was eighth, Don Harp 17th, Bill Borcherdt 25th and Jeff Becker 29th.

The girls collected 114 points to finish behind Schofield (29), Port Washington (69), Valders (100) and St. Joseph Academy (108).

Mindy Crum was eighth, Kelly Owen 11th, Jenny Arndt 20th, Paula Rider 27th, Deena Andrews 37th, Kathy Madsen 38th and Heidi Weingartner 53rd.
