# Rocket runners defend honors in Shawano

NEENAH — The Neenah girls' cross country team will defend its championship in the Shawano Invitational Saturday after repeating a victory in the Brookfield East Invitational last weekend.

The Neenah boys, who were ninth in their division at Brookfield, also will run in the Shawano meet.

The Rocket girls boosted their string of victories to nine since last year's second-place finish to Stevens Point.

They tallied 33 points to Waukesha Memorial's 63 in Division II.

Waukesha North won Division I with 36 points, and Rocket Coach Ron Fedenko said it would have been a close finish had the two teams been in the same race.

For the second time in as many starts, Eileen Schaller edged teammate Kathy Monard for individual honors.

Schaller won in 11:33.9 and Monard posted 11:34.

Amy Garlock was fifth in 12:26, freshman Jenny Owens seventh in 12:28, Cathy Gilmore 18th in 13:09, and Lyn Moede 33rd, Anne Fischer 37th and Jan Shaper 43rd.

Fedenko said the times were much better than in last year's race. Schaller bettered her time by seven seconds, Monard by 50 and Garlock by a minute.

Becky Otto was 13th in the junior varsity race. Karen Reiden and Linda Heinen, a newcomer to the team, also ran.

The Neenah boys totaled 283 in their division, won by Menomonee Falls with 62.

First place went to Bill Hacker of Menomonee Falls in 15:44. He formerly represented Menomonee Falls

North before the city's two schools merged.

Neenah finishes were Scott Meulemans, 44th; Jeff Wheeler, 55th; Glen Smith, 57th; Alex Scriber, 62nd; Russ Stern, 65th; Pete Dunlavy, 67th, and Jeff Enz, 68th.

Jeff Christian and Barry Tebon ran with the junior varsity.
