Harriers bid for league honors

NEENAH — The Neenah boys' and girls' cross country teams will compete in the 17th annual Fox Valley Association meet at Kaukauna Thursday afternoon.

The schedule calls for the jayvee girls and open race at 3:30 p.m., jayvee boys at 4 p.m., varsity boys at 4:30 and varsity girls at 5 p.m.

If the course is muddy, the schedule may be reversed so that the varsity races can be held in the best possible conditions.

Kaukauna snapped the Neenah girls' 6-year reign last year via a 63-64 score, while Appleton East won its third straight boys' crown.

Neenah's returning runners include Jenny Owens, who was second; Amy Garlock, fifth, and Kayann Monard, eighth.

Owens and Garlock have been hampered by illness and injuries. Owens was 14th in the Waukesha Memorial Invitational last weekend. Monard finished sixth. The Rocket team was fourth.

The Neenah boys placed second to East 44 to 85 a year ago. Returnees Alex Scribner was 12th and Jeff Reeve 13th.

The Rockets were 10th in the weekend Waukesha meet, led by Reeve's 24th place.

Earlier in the week, the Rockets totaled 35 points to best Kaukauna and Appleton West, both with 59, and Oshkosh West (70) in a quadrangular.

The Neenah girls placed third with

62 points behind Appleton West (38) and Kaukauna (50) and ahead of Oshkosh West (70).

Menasha was third in the conference boys' meet and sixth in girls' competition a year ago.

Leading returnee for the girls is Jenny Arndt, who was 25th.

Individual champion Tom Severson of the Bluejays graduated. None of the other top finishers are back.

Menasha's girls placed seventh in the recent Racine Case Invitational with 200 points. The race consisted of 10 runners instead of the usual seven.

Arndt was the Bluejays' leading finisher, followed by Jenni Siehr, Kerry Decker, Wendy Schuer, Rachel VanderWielien, Andrea Severson, Vicki Waskiewicz and Jenny VanDeHey.

Because of the lack of numbers, Coach Terry Langan didn't enter a team in the boys' varsity race although the jayvees competed.

The Bluejay girls were edged by Oshkosh North 31-35 in a triangular at Appleton East last week. The Patriots were third with 58. Arndt finished third.

The Menasha boys were fourth with 98 points. North had 34, Appleton East 35 and Kimberly 69.

St. Mary's girls placed second to Mayville in the Princeton Invitational. Becky Otto won the race.
