Hard work is backbone of Neenah girls' success

NEENAH — Hard work is leading to success for the Neenah girls' cross country team.

So far this season, the Rocket runners have won a Fox Valley Association five-team meet, the Rhinelander Invitational, the Shawano Invitational, the Oshkosh North Invitational and took second place by six points to defending state champion Waukesha West in the Milwaukee Marquette Invitational.

"They're working real hard," Neenah coach Ron Fedenko said of his team. "They're definitely not afraid of it, and you don't have to push them. They'll go out and do it and they won't complain. They know that if they work hard it will pay dividends."

And the Rockets, who finished second at the state meet last year, are gaining confidence as their success builds.

"They are getting confident seeing that they are competitive," Fedenko said. "We are capable of running with anyone in the state."

Although Fedenko is pleased with the way the season is progressing, he cau-

tions that the Rockets must continue working hard and improving.

"I'm real pleased with how everyone is doing and with the success we've had," he said. "We have had excellent practices, but we want to keep working. We've got to get our times a little quicker. I don't think that we've peaked yet."

Leading the way for the Rockets are Julie Olson, Christy Codner, Meghan Patterson, Christy McCutcheon, Sara Codner, Krista Erickson and Missy Klabunde. That those runners have been heading the pack for the Rockets comes as no surprise to Fedenko.

"It's pretty much as we've expected it to be," he said. "Our top seven girls return

from last year, and as a group all of them have been running very well. Basically, it's been our veterans that have returned that have held on to the varsity spots."

And that group of runners will determine just how far the Rockets can go.

"I definitely feel that we can be a competitive team," Fedenko added. "We'll see

some good teams at the Crusader Invitational (in Waukesha) before our conference meet that will give us a good idea of how we stack up. We finished second at state last year, and I don't think the girls expected us to do that. Anything can happen when you get down there."
