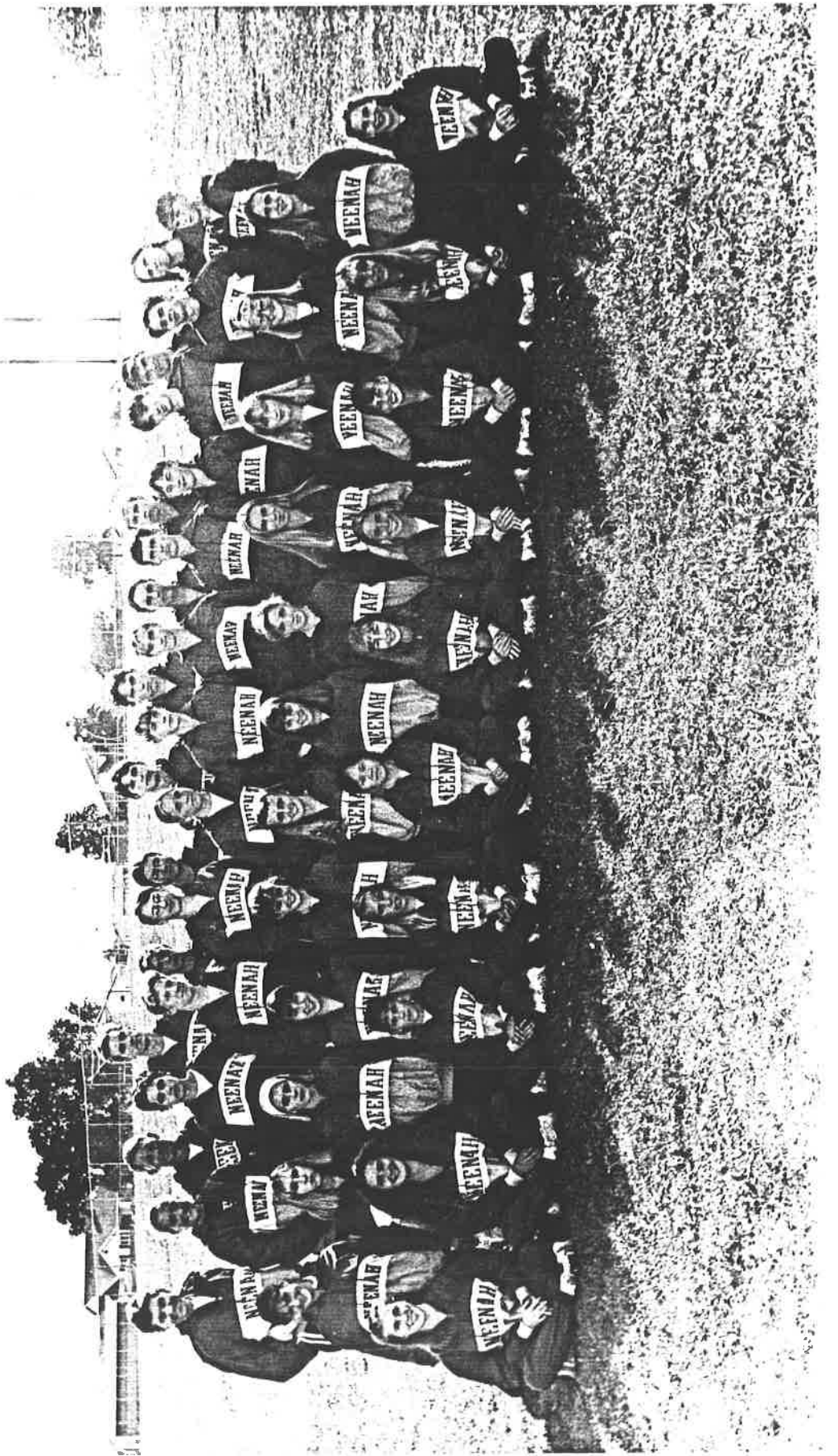

Veteran harriers lead Neenah team

■ The Rockets have three- and four-year runners on the roster

NEENAH — If the names on the Neenah High School girls cross country team have a familiar ring to them, it shouldn't be surprising to followers of the running sport.

The Neenah squad of 21 candidates, the largest in coach Ron Fedenko's 12-year tenure, includes several seniors, who are beginning their fourth year on the varsity; juniors starting their third seasons; and sophomores, who are running for the second campaigns.

And the girls made an impressive debut last week by winning a five-team Fox Valley Association meet and placing first by 52 points in Saturday's Hodag Invitational at Rhinelander.

Last year's Rockets were ~~unbeaten~~ ^{2nd one loss} until finishing ~~third~~ in the WIAA state meet. They won the conference and sectional championships along the way.

Leading the returnees are four-year veterans Julie Olson and Christy Codner.

Olson was fourth in the conference meet, seventh in the sectional and 30th at state last fall.

Junior returnees include Missy Klabunde, Meghan Patterson and Krista Erickson, while sophomores lettering as freshmen are Christy McCutcheon and Sara Codner.

McCutcheon was second in the conference, fourth at sectional and 20th at state, and Patterson placed fifth in the league and sectional runs and 23rd at state.

In this season's initial meets, Patterson was second, Olson fourth, Christy Codner sixth, McCutcheon seventh and Sara Codner eighth at Rhinelander. Olson was second, Christy Codner third, Patterson fifth, Sara Codner eighth and McCutcheon ninth in the five-team meet.

Karen Schaper, a three-year letterwinner, didn't report because of an injury.

Krisa Lawell was the only letter recipient lost by graduation.

Non-lettering squad members returning include seniors Julee Beckstrom and Mysea Moua; junior Lisa Heroux; and sophomores Mandy Gunderson and Holly Goudreau.

Sophomores Megan Mutchler and Liz Stielow ran with the Shattuck ninth grade squad last fall, while freshman candidates include Sarah Brey, Shayna Brown, Alicia Hilliker, Danielle Johnson, Heather Michalkiewicz, Noelle Miller and Sara Mulroy.

The girls will have to run longer to complete a race this season because since the course has been extended from 3,200 meters from 4,000 meters.

Fedenko said that the Rockets entered the season in fairly decent shape, indicating that they worked out during the summer.
