NHS runners record sweep

The Neenah boys and girls both win their events at Shawano

SHAWANO — The Neenah boys and girls cross country teams continued to dominate the Shawano Invitational by sweeping to first place in both divisions Saturday morning.

The Shawano championship was the sixth in a row for both squads.

The boys have won 13 titles since 1962 and the girls have won 12 since 1980.

The boys captured their meet with 68 points, three less than runner-up Green Bay East and 10 fewer than perennial power Green Bay Preble.

Menasha finished eighth in the nine-team field with 256 points, one less than Green Bay West.

The Rockets easily won the girls meet with 42 points. Green Bay East finished second with 81, Manitowoc had 123 for third and Menasha placed seventh with 166.

Menasha sophomore Katie Olander, who came in fourth, produced the best finish by a Twin City runner.

Neenah's Krstine Berg was sixth; Becky Probst, seventh; Tina Schraufnabel, eighth; Kristi Morris, 10th;

Kim Steffens, 11th; Danelle Johnson, 15th; Heather Michalkiewicz, 16th; and Kate Pedersen, 18th.

The second-best finish for the Bluejays went to Gina Witt in 33rd place, Christel Dalke was 36th.

Paul Mason sparked the Neenah boys with a fifth-place finish. Teammate Ryan Waterstreet was sixth, three seconds behind Mason.

Other Neenah places were Jason Olson, 14th; Mike Vogel, 21st; Ryan Lenerz, 22nd; Allan Henschel, 31st; Twayann Carr, 33rd; and Nick Madsen, 36th.

For Menasha, Keith Hofkens was 37th and Jon Hassell 44th.

The Neenah No. 1 boys junior varsity team garnered first place with 22 points; the No. 2 squad was second with 52; and No. 3 came in eighth with 202.

Neenah's Brian Koslowski was the individual winner in 18:24.

Ben Johnson took second place, three seconds behind Koslowski, and Adam Christnovich was third; Adam Buckingham, fourth; Eric Smiltneek, sixth; Jesse Neller, eighth; Shawn Albee, ninth; Jason Chapman, 10th; Eric Murray, 13th; Josh Olson, 18th; Andy Turner, 20th; Andy Lundt, 23rd; Ryan Wenzel, 27th; and Seth

Fellenz, 36th.

Neenah's teams also claimed the first two places in the girls junior varsity race with 19 and 78 points.

The No. 1 team was sixth with 153 and Menasha finished 12th with 404.

Neenah's finishers were Lindsey Wilhelm, first in 17:25; Kristi Niemi, second; Briana Schultz, third; Marni Burton, fourth; Lori Wilson, fifth; Theresa Foulks, seventh; Amy Michalkiewicz, 11th; Stephanie Abney, 12th; Ann Vedder, 14th; Jessica VanderLinden, 15th; Kathy Ziegert, 16th; Angela Kapthingst, 18th; Erin Fischer, 21st; Tricia Wallingford, 23rd; Sarah Brey, 24th; Jenna Smith, 27th; and Robyn Barnett, 34th.

ST. MARY CENTRAL: The Zephyr boys were third in the small-school division at the Manitowoc Roncalli Invitational with 270 points.
