Throup earns trip to Hawaiian Ironman

Appleton's Nancy Throup went to Canada and won a trip to Hawaii.

Oh, there is a catch. While in paradise, Throup has to swim 2.4 miles in the ocean, bike 112 miles and run a marathon. All in the same day.

it with a time of 16 hours, 32 minutes and 41 seconds. "It was like the carrot hanging in front of my face. And my daughters were waiting at the finish line, and there was no way I was going to disappoint them."
