Throup earns trip to Hawaiian Ironman

Appleton's Nancy Throup went to Canada and won a trip to Hawaii.

Oh, there is a catch. While in paradise, Throup has to swim 2.4 miles in the ocean, bike 112 miles and run a marathon. All in the same day.

The scenery is sure to be breathtaking, though the hot and windy conditions will also likely take her breath away. But congratulations, Nancy, we think.

You see, the 50-year-old Throup just completed the Canadian Ironman triathlon on Sunday, and the Hawaiian Ironman, regarded as the world championships, is Oct. 6. That's not exactly a lot of time to recoup, for anyone of any age.

"It's not," Throup said. "It certainly is going to be a test of my abilities on this one."

Throup was part of a group of 14 area triathletes who trained and did the Canadian Ironman together. She qualified for Hawaii by placing second in the 50-54 age group.

"It was a real surprise," said Throup, who competed earlier in the year for Team USA, a triathlon team that competed in shorter distances. "I was somewhat burnt out on racing, but I decided to go because I had a lot

of friends going up there. ... I was quite surprised I placed second and got the Hawaii spot and, of course, you can't turn those down."

Jean Blank of Neenah was another member of that group, but this was her first go-round in this kind of event. But she made it.

"All day long, I didn't know if I'd get through it or not," said the 51-year-old Blank. "For 16 hours, it was a question mark."

But she persevered and received the reward she set out to get.

"The finishing medal is a medal like no other medal," said Blank, who beat the 17-hour time limit with a time of 16 hours, 32 minutes and 41 seconds. "It was like the carrot hanging in front of my face. And my daughters were waiting at the finish line, and there was no way I was going to disappoint them."
