Dear Coach:

Welcome to the 47th Annual Fond du Lac Memorial Invitational, to be held Friday, September 30, 2016. The meet will be hosted at Rolling Meadows Golf Course. The course is run on grass with only a couple small sections of limestone golf cart paths; spikes are permitted. This meet is dedicated to Jamie Burroughs, Josh Huey, Adam McCullough and Dan Schneider, the four Fond du Lac Cross Country runners who died in a car accident on August 14, 1993.

Your team's cooperation is essential to conduct an orderly and efficient meet and to continue the cross country tradition at Rolling Meadows for future years. The meet will be using holes 1-9. The golf course is still open for business on holes 10 through 27 including the driving range, so teams and spectators are asked to respect the following restricted areas:

- Holes that are not part of the CC course (holes 10-27; center and right side of golf course)
- Any roped off areas around the course
- The finish chute and official areas
- Tees, greens, and bunkers
- The clubhouse and locker rooms

<u>Entries</u>

Coaches are strongly encouraged to submit their entries through athletic.net. A spreadsheet template may be available upon request.

<u>Arrival</u>

Your bus may unload in the Rolling Meadows parking lot. Busses should then be parked on Holiday Lane across from Rolling Meadows Drive. **PLEASE SHARE THIS INFORMATION WITH YOUR BUS DRIVERS.** Tents and team camp areas are limited to the area along the south edge of the parking lot and to the south side of the club house. **Team packets will be available near the finish line in the timing trailer.** Course maps will be provided.

<u>Parking</u>

The parking area closest to the clubhouse on the north end is reserved for golfers. Spectators should park on the far south side of the lot farthest away from the entrance and closest to the start and finish lines. Absolutely no busses are allowed to park in the parking lot.
