- DATE: Thursday October 5, 2017
- SITE: The meet will be held at Tendick Nature Park. The park is located about 2 miles north of Saukville on County Highway O.
- PARKING: All buses will park inside of the Tendick Park. All spectators must park on the other side of the road in a remote lot and take the shuttle bus or walk to the course. The County has posted No parking signs along the road and will enforce these no parking zones. Please inform your spectators.
- COURSE: The course is mostly open prairie. There is a small patch of woods with a wood chip trail. Spikes are recommended. Both the boys and girls will race at 5000m. Maps of the course have been attached with the email and more will be available when you arrive.
