

## CROSS COUNTRY

**Miller, McDonald lead strong Neenah showing:** It was more of the same for the Neenah coed cross country team, which turned in another strong overall performance at last Saturday's Port Washington Invitational.

On the boys' side, the Rockets took first out of 13 teams with 34 points, finishing well in front of runner-up Beaver Dam, which wound up with 117 points.

Neenah had four runners finish in the top 10, including Jason Miller, who took first with a time of 15:59.

Also placing high for the Rockets were Nick Westphal (second, 16:11), Adam Swanson (fourth, 16:29) and Tim Burns (10th, 16:52).

On the girls' side, Betsy McDonald won the meet title for the fourth straight year with a time of 14:20.

McDonald's time broke her own record.

Overall, the Rockets finished second with 67 points, while Whitefish Bay took first with 66.

Also figuring into the scoring were Emily Burns (11th, 15:34), Jill Winkler (13th, 15:43), Andrea Stier (20th, 15:59) and Tara Schraufnagel (22nd, 16:02).
