  - o The large white tent on the north side of the clubhouse

- No soccer balls, frisbees, etc. allowed
- Please use portable restrooms. The clubhouse is off limits

## Fond du Lac Memorial Invitational 2400m Middle School Course

The course is two loops.

Middle school runners will use a portion of the same course as the high school runners. They will turn left near hole #8 and then merge with the high school course on the gravel golf cart path that leads to hole #2.

The cut-off point to begin the 2nd loop splits from the finish line approach and merges with the start area on the fairway.
