Schafer has come a long way to run at state


eenah High school senior Rocky Schafer has run through all obstacles in cross country.

As a sophomore, he couldn't run in the Rockets' track regional because he was diagnosed with a possible stress fracture.

D-5 "My hip was sore. It was inflamed," he said. "I felt it right away at state.'

So Schafer ran in pain. It was agonizing every

step of the way, but the kid endured.

"Toward the end, it got so painful that I felt like walking," he said. "But then I told myself that I worked so hard, and God gave me this talent to get to state, so I should keep going.

Schafer finished, but he was last, and that dampened his spirits.

"I was about 150th," he said. "It was kind of the worst feeling in the world being injured at state."

Schafer's back-of-thepack finish didn't bother his parents, though. In fact, Cindy and Robert

Schafer were impressed. So were Schafer's coach and teammates.

We were proud of him," Cindy Schafer said. 'We knew he had very strong determination and how important cross cour try is to him. It would have been so easy for him to stop.

There was no way Schafer was going to stop "I worked all year for that moment - to be at state. I didn't want to give in to the pain," he said.

But in April, he learned that he had a non-cancerous bone tumor in the tibia area of his right foot. The family thanked God that it wasn't cancerous. Still, last May 8, Schafer underwent surgery.

"They took a half an inch of bone during it," Schafer said. "I was on crutches for three

weeks."

With his injury problems, no one would have blamed Schafer

if he had chosen to forget cross country this year. It was August before he began his running routine again.



But his coach and teammates

knew that Schafer would be there when the season started. And he was.

"Rocky has always been kind

of inspiring to the rest of the guys," said Miller, a senior. "We look up to him because of all the things he's gone through."

Because he didn't run during the summer, Schafer got off to a shaky to start this cross country season. He said that during the Neenah Invitational on Aug. 31, he got down on himself.

I was getting side aches," he said. "Everyone else was way ahead of me. I even lost my varsity spot and was moved to the JVs. I thought about quitting.

Schafer's thoughts of leaving

cross country didn't last long. Again, he battled back to earn a berth on the all-Fox Valley Association's second team.

"He's a very genuine person who has his way of putting the team at ease," Morgen said.

Genuine is a good way to describe Rocky Schafer. When it comes to overcoming the odds and reaching for the sky, this kidis the real deal.
